The Plaza Hotel is at the East End. Fremont Street is covered from the Plaza to Las Vegas Blvd. There are many casinos up and down the street with restaurants. The first link lists most of those. The Main Street Station Casino is next to the Plaza and has a nice buffet with a lot of room for seating big parties. Price isn't too bad. The website says "limited" dinner, but we ate there for the midyear meeting and it was fine.

At the opposite end of the Fremont Experience, across Las Vegas Blvd, there are many gastropubs and trendy restaurants. It's a little further to walk, but it is doable. Here is a link to those restaurants. <https://fremonteast.com/eat-drink/>
