Copy of a weekend team list from your secretariat

Things to bring if you're staying onsite:

Clothes for Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday (outfits, underwear, socks)

Shoes or sandals

Nightwear

Flip-flops or slip on shoes to wear to bathroom and/or in shower

Robe to wear to bathroom

Personal items such as:

- CPap (host committee will have distilled water available)
- Nightguard, retainer, cleaning container and cleaning tablets
- Toiletries – shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, toothpaste/toothbrush/floss, comb
- Rx's plus Tums and Advil
- Lip balm, hand lotion

Optional things to bring if you're staying onsite:

Bible

Pilgrim's guide

Cell phone and charger

iPad and charger

Powerstrip for plugging in cell phone, iPad, CPap

Pillow – a new pillow will be provided to each person registered to stay onsite

Bath towel – a towel will be provided to each person registered to stay onsite

Fitted twin sheet (long) – sheets will be provided to each person registered to stay onsite

Blanket – a blanket will be provided to each person registered to stay onsite

Rain jacket, poncho, and/or umbrella

Sunglasses

Snacks for eating while traveling – veggies, fruit, salties, sweets

Hand sanitizer

Tissues

Trash bag or zip lock bag

First aid kit – cleanser and Band-Aids
